We Believe

There is no more outrageous claim than what Christians have insisted for more than 2,000 years. Despite our ultimate death and returning to dust (Genesis 3:19), our existence has really just begun.

This makes no sense whatsoever. Who could blame anyone who might look at us as if we have lost our senses?

We believe that God has given us a soul that we cannot observe, that remains for eternity. The unbelieving insists that everything we see, all that we observe, all that we are, came from nothing. Believers and non-believers alike have faith in what we cannot see.

Which is more difficult to accept, that design and order came from nothing, or that design and order came from a Designer?

In five short verses, we are told that Jesus is God, that He was there in the beginning of creation, that everything we observe is owed to him, and why, apart from Christ, we cannot understand.

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.” - John 1:1-5

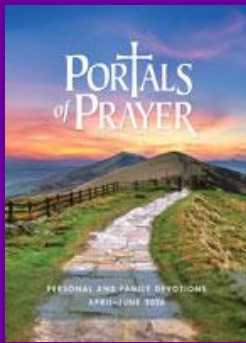
