#### **Dog Days of Faith**

Nabeel Qureshi, a devout Muslim, was struggling with his faith. He and his Christian friend had been in friendly debates over Christianity and Islam for several years. When the evidence for the God of the Bible was too overwhelming, he cried out to God for a sign, a clear indication that He was God.

What followed was a vision of glowing crosses in the empty room where he was standing. Nabeel was stunned ... and then said, "God, that doesn't count."

Even when the evidence is overwhelming, faith in God, whether a new follower of Christ or a lifelong follower, can face challenges.

In the book of John, we read about followers of Jesus leaving Him when he was teaching difficult doctrine, including eating the flesh and drinking the blood of Jesus. Looking at the Twelve, Jesus asks, "You do not want to leave too, do you?" To which Peter replies, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God" (John 6:67-69).

Even the most stalwart of Christian Fathers throughout history have shared how they struggled with their faith in difficult times. We are humans with finite understanding, trying to understand an infinite God.

Nabeel Qureshi was baptized by his Christian friend and faced a difficult time when he told his loving mother and father of his conversion. But he persevered and, upon graduation from medical school, he decided not to practice medicine but to minister to Muslims. Qureshi was faithful to the Gospel of Jesus to the end of his short life, succumbing to aggressive cancer at the age of 33, leaving a wife and child.

Making sense of the events of this world – injustices, natural disasters, illnesses, and death- is beyond our comprehension. We can grow bitter and angry, or we can conclude as Peter did, if not You, Lord, then who?

#### **Stewardship Corner**

Luke 12:15 – "And he said to them, 'Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." Coveting is the opposite of being content with what God has given us. And the cure for coveting is twofold: thankfulness to God and generosity toward God's purposes. So be on guard against all covetousness. Acknowledge that your Father has given you all you need, and therefore be free and confident in directing the mammon of this world toward godly purposes.

No pre-registration needed. The next meeting will take place




