BECOMING A VOTING MEMBER: Any confirmed member of St. Trinity who is 18 years or older can become a voting member by attending a regular Voters' Assembly and register to become a voting member. You will then be eligible to vote at the **NEXT** Voters' Assembly (regular or special).

Any voting member who has missed 4 consecutive regular Voters' Assemblies shall be considered inactive until you attend a Regular Voters' Assembly. In order for an inactive voting member to become active again, you must attend a Regular Voters' Assembly, and sign-in. You will then be allowed to vote at the **NEXT** Voters' Assembly (regular or special).

You may get more information on this from the Constitution and Bylaws. Copies of these are available by request from the church office.

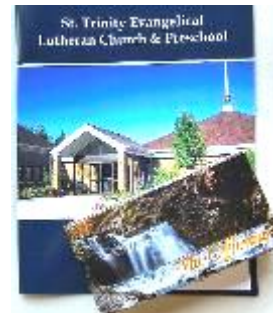

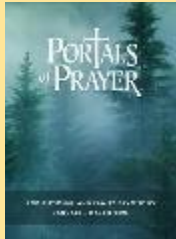
