An Act of God

Mankind has a long track record of seeking ways to glorify other humans, including ourselves.

On more than one occasion, the apostles argued over which one of them was the greatest. Not much has changed today. We argue over which celebrity, athlete, and even politician is the *greatest*.

We can even elevate *our opinions* about these people in the public eye to greatness.

But what if the person or group we held in such high esteem was corrupt? Imagine they were not only accused of some pretty awful acts, but it turns out they were guilty of these acts. We might feel foolish and a bit embarrassed over our endorsement of someone with such a record.

It can be said with great certainty, in fact, with 100% confidence, that we all are admiring people who are so hopelessly lost and corrupt that to fix them, to fix all of us, requires an Act of God.

The Easter Season is a reminder that *our sins* put Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, on the cross. We all stand guilty before a Holy God. Further, there is no one in this earthly realm whom we admire who can save us from this condition.

Before we, as the apostles, argue over who is the greatest, let us humble ourselves before our God and remember that our broken human condition required an Act of God to save us.

“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God, not by works, so that no one can boast.” Ephesians 2:8-9


The Board of Human Care is collecting needed items for the Detroit Veterans Hospital.
