Please bring a salad, side dish, or dessert to share.

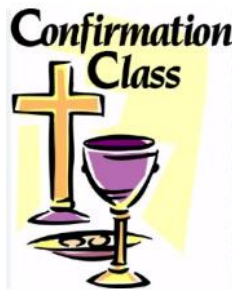
